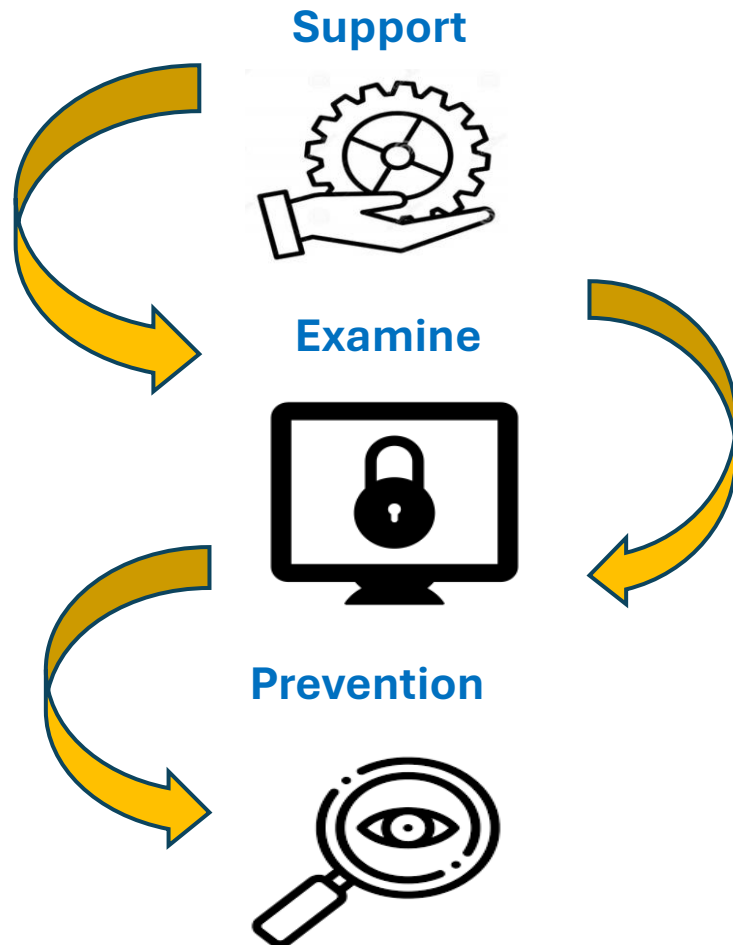

Responsibilities



Cyber Forensics

Triage and full examination of centrally assigned investigations and requests for forensic examinations or OSINT, data collection requests.

Cyber Investigations

Carry out and support investigations of cyber incidents of complaints, searches within hub catchment area. Collate intelligence on trends, local victimology and risks to formulate cyber safety and security advice.



Partnerships

Working with colleagues and local communities to build cyber resilience and awareness, and to foster prevention and cyber safety capability through partnerships and engagement.

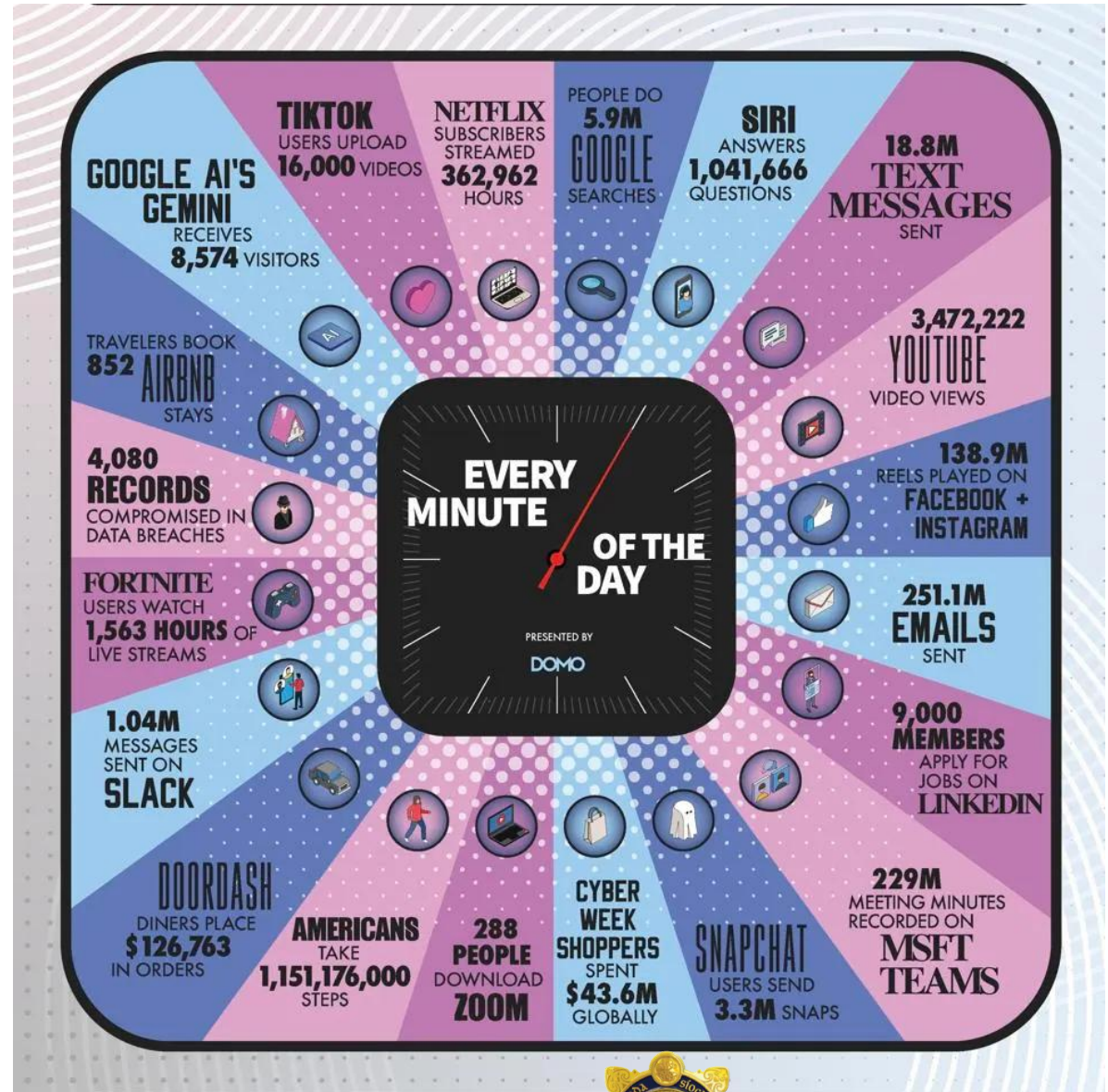
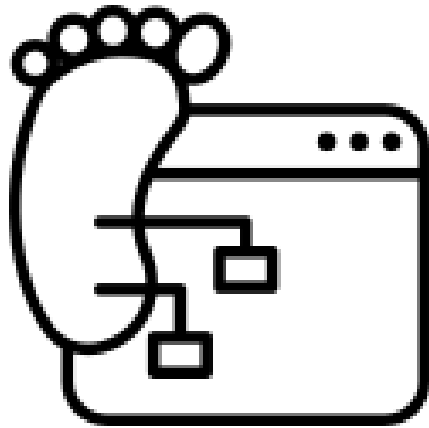
